

## INSTRUCTION TO AUTHORS

The manuscript and two paper copies should be sent to the Editor-in-Chief, Prof. Gianpietro Semenzato, Università degli Studi di Padova, Dipartimento di Medicina Clinica e Sperimentale dell'Università, Via Giustiniani 2, 35128 Padova, Italy; Tel. +39 049 8212298; Fax +39 049 8754179; E-mail: g.semenzato@unipd.it.

The Journal does not hold itself responsible for statements made by contributors or for loss or damage of mailed manuscripts. They should be accompanied by an undertaking that they are submitted to this Journal only. Papers must be submitted in English. Papers are accepted on the understanding that they may be subject to editorial revision. The majority of papers published in the Journal report original research in the field of granulomatous disorders, vasculitis and diffuse lung disorders. All Original Articles are subject to review and authors are urged to be brief. Long papers with many tables and figures may require shortening if they are to be accepted for publication. All manuscripts should include a total text word count and an abstract word count on the cover page. Total text word count does not include title page, figure legends, references, or tables. Only under exceptional circumstances will Original Articles longer than 5500 words be considered, and under no circumstances will abstracts greater than 250 words be published. Editorials and Reviews are normally invited contributions but suitable papers may be submitted to the Editor for consideration for this purpose. The submission of Case Reports is not encouraged. These will only be considered if the report includes novel scientific material or is of exceptional clinical interest. The presentation of Case Reports should be as short as possible. Reports of coexistence of two diseases or conditions without proof of causal relationship are discouraged. Letters to the Editor should not exceed 600 words of text, one figure or table and up to six references. Because of space limitation, publication of submitted Letters will depend on priority rating.

TITLE PAGE must contain:

- a concise informative title
- author(s) names
- department or institution where work was done
- name and address of author to whom correspondence about the manuscript and request for reprints should be referred, as well as Fax, E-mail and telephone number
- a running title of no more than 40 characters.

Be certain to list the FAX number and E-mail of the corresponding author on the title page. **All correspondence (excluding submission and resubmission) will be by FAX or E-mail only.**

MANUSCRIPTS should be typed in 12-point type and double spacing should be used throughout. There should be an abstract of not more than 250 words including 4 paragraphs labeled: Background and aim of the work, Methods, Results, and Conclusions. Below the abstract provide 3-10 key words that will assist indexers in cross-indexing the article. Paragraphs to be set in a smaller type should be marked with an "s" (small) in the left hand margin. Avoid footnotes; when essential they should be numbered consecutively and typed at the foot of the appropriate page. Authors of accepted and revised manuscripts are required to submit the final version on disk for typesetting. Three hard-copy versions of the manuscript identical to the disk are always required.

ILLUSTRATIONS. It is the authors' responsibility to obtain permission (from the author and copyright holder) to reproduce illustrations, tables, etc from other publications. Prints or radiographs must be clear. Photographs and photomicrographs should be printed on glossy paper and submitted unmounted, identified by a number (Arabic numerals) and author's name on the top back. Typewritten or free-hand lettering is unacceptable. Do not send original artwork, x-ray films or ECG tracings. Glossy print photographs are preferred; good black and white contrast is essential. The base should have the same size as a column of the Journal (8 cm). A letter of permission must accompany all photographs when there is a possibility of identification. Authors must pay for colour illustrations. Present rate for a full page colour illustration about \$600-1200. Final quotation will be given by the publisher. Original colour transparencies as well as two sets of colour prints should be submitted. Legends should be typed on a separate sheet.

TABLES should be numbered consecutively with Roman numerals. Type each Table on a separate sheet, with self-explanatory titles. We do not welcome large Tables of unanalysed data.

REFERENCES should be numbered consecutively in the order in which they appear in the text. References cited only in Tables or in Legends to Figures should

be numbered in accordance with the sequence established by the first identification in the text. The list of references should be typed in numerical order of authors' names (all authors when six or less; when seven or more list only the first three and add et al); article title, name of the Journal (abbreviated as in Index Medicus), publication year, volume and first and last page numbers. Example: Rizzato G, Marazzini L: Thoracoabdominal mechanics in elderly men. J Appl Physiol 1970; 28: 457-60. If the reference is concerning a book, give authors' names, full title and, in brackets, name and domicile of publisher and publication year. Personal communications should not be included in the references but may be cited in the text in parentheses.

TRANSFER OF AUTHOR COPYRIGHT. Please include a signed release of copyright to SARCOIDOSIS VASCULITIS AND DIFFUSE LUNG DISEASES with your manuscript. Include the title of the article being submitted, as well as the date. Include the signatures of coauthors.

GALLEY PROOFS. Unless indicated otherwise, galley proofs are sent to the first author and should be returned without delay. Alterations to galley proofs, other than those due to printer's error, are charged to the author. Accepted and rejected manuscripts are retained for six months after publication or rejection, then destroyed.

REPRINTS. 50 reprints without covers or .pdf file will be supplied free to the first author, if requested when sending back galley proofs. Additional reprints are available at cost if they are ordered when the proof is returned. Order form and a price list are sent with the galley proofs; payment must be made with the order. Reprints for letters to the Editor are supplied only at cost.
